Campus Research Officer

As the Campus Research Officer, you will be the expert on antisemitism on campus and in the student world. You will make sure, via the reports you write, presentations you provide and research you undertake, that CST has and maintains institutional knowledge and authority on this key area of communal concern.

You will develop and build an understanding of the nature of the threat to Jewish students and the way it varies on different campuses across the UK. You will coordinate your work closely with other key internal stakeholders to ensure information is shared in a timely fashion.

In addition, you will work collaboratively with various communal organisations including the Union of Jewish Students and other relevant organisations and individuals who help you achieve your role of understanding and combatting antisemitism on campus.

Key areas of responsibility include:

- To develop online tools to assist you in your research work
- To write threat assessments for events being held on campus that relate to Jewish students
- To ensure antisemitic incidents on campus are reported to CST
- To provide senior CST staff updates regarding the situation of antisemitism on campus
- To provide weekly campus updates to CST staff and communal partners of pertinent information relating to activities on campus

The ideal candidate should have:

- Excellent understanding of the threats affecting the Jewish community
- Strong communication skills, both orally and in writing
- Demonstrable abilities to research primary source data
- Delivery of reports in a professional and timely manner
- Possess the ability to work under pressure
- Exceptional understanding of antisemitism, what constitutes antisemitic discourse
- Excellent interpersonal skills with a natural ability to build strong relationships
- Excellent research skills and high proficiency with social media
- Superb organiser with a professional and mature manner
- Ability to work flexible hours, to be proactive, resourceful and prepared to travel around the UK consistently
