National Student Security Co-ordinator

Full time 2-year contract, based in Manchester

The National Student Security Co-ordinator will play a key role in dealing and working with youth and Jewish students on university campuses in the Northern regions. They will also be responsible for dealing with victims of antisemitism. You will be expected to frequently travel to a number of campuses during the course of the role.

Duties include:

- Organising security for student events
- Building up strong working relationships with Jewish Societies
- Providing support to those who have been a victim of antisemitism on campus
- Responsible for administrative tasks relating to antisemitic incidents in the Jewish student community
- Key liaison person between the police and university security staff
- Responsible for maintaining and the recruitment of new security volunteers from the student community

The ideal candidate should have:

- Great communication and organisational skills
- Possess a maturity when dealing with confidential matters
- Excellent time management skills
- Capable of working under pressure
- Ability to motivate and inspire people
- Ability to work accurately to strict deadlines, prioritise workload and work under pressure
- Genuine commitment to supporting the work and development of the CST

A valid UK driving licence is required for this role as you will have use of a company car. The job offers a competitive salary plus great staff benefits.
